Application for Expansion of Corunna Facility within 1.6 km of the Dow Moore Storage Pool

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 4 September 11, 2015

On January 22, 2015 Pembina Infrastructure and Logistics LP (Pembina) applied to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) pursuant to section 11(2) of the *Oil, Gas and Salt Resources Act* (OSGRA) for approval to expand the storage capacity of natural gas liquids salt caverns storage facility in St. Clair Township in the County of Lambton (Corunna Facility). The Corunna Facility is located within 1.6 km of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s Dow Moore Designated Storage Area. As required by section 11(2) of the OSGRA the MNRF referred this application to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for approval.

On September 9, 2015 Pembina, by way of a letter, asked the OEB to place the proceeding in abeyance (Abeyance Request) for the following reasons:

- RESPEC Inc. has informed Pembina that it requires additional time to complete additional Geomechanical Assessment for the entire Corunna Facility.
- Pembina further requested additional time to file further evidence on Risk Assessment in order to address the deficiencies identified by the MNRF in its written submissions.

The additional Geomechanical Assessment and Risk Assessment will provide the OEB with a more complete record of the proceeding which will assist the OEB in its determination of the application. Accordingly, the OEB will grant Pembina's Abeyance Request until such time that Pembina notifies that the OEB that it has filed the additional evidence as specified in the Abeyance Request.

The OEB will also order that the procedural schedule set in the Procedural Order No. 3 be annulled. A new procedural schedule will be set at the time the proceeding is reinstated.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The OEB orders that EB-2015-0032 be held in abeyance until such time that Pembina informs the OEB that it has filed the additional Geomechanical Assessment for the entire Corruna Facility and Risk Assessment.
- 2. The dates set for the filing of submissions and other procedural steps set in the Procedural Order No. 3 are cancelled.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2015-0032 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.
