Application for pre-approval of the recovery of the cost consequences associated with the installation of three new compressors along Union's Dawn to Parkway pipeline transmission system.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 4 October 5, 2015

Union Gas Limited (Union) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 30, 2015 pursuant to section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, for preapproval of the recovery of the cost consequences associated with the installation of three new compressors and associated facilities on the Dawn-Parkway transmission system. The total estimated cost of the project is \$622.5 million.

A Notice was issued on July 21, 2015 and was served and posted as per the direction of the OEB.

The OEB issued a procedural order on August 17, 2015 setting out a revised process for filing interrogatories and responses to interrogatories. Accordingly, Board staff and intervenors filed interrogatories on September 8, 2015 and Union filed responses to the interrogatories on September 22, 2015.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE OEB THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- A Technical Conference involving OEB staff, intervenors and Union will be convened on October 15, 2015 starting at 9:30 a.m. The Technical Conference will be held in the OEB's North Hearing Room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto.
- A Settlement Conference will be convened at 9:30 a.m. on October 20 and 21, 2015, with the objective of reaching a settlement among the parties on the issues. The Settlement Conference will be held in the OEB's North Hearing Room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto.

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- 4. Any settlement proposal arising from the Settlement Conference shall be filed with the Board no later than 4:45 p.m. on **November 16, 2015**.
- 5. If a settlement proposal is filed, OEB staff's submission on the settlement proposal shall be filed with the Board and served on all parties within **7 days** from when any settlement proposal is filed.
- 6. If there is no settlement proposal arising from the Settlement Conference, Union shall file a statement to that effect with the Board by **November 6, 2015**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2015-0200 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>. wo paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.
