LETTER OF DIRECTION

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Enersource's 2016 incentive regulation mechanism application (Notice). The Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 through 3 below **prior to November 5, 2015**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. You are directed:

1. 2. If Enersource is a Host Distributor, to no later than the date the Notice is posted on Enersource's website in accordance with paragraph 3, serve a copy of the enclosed English and French versions of the Notice directly on its Embedded Distributor(s).
3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice available for public review at Enersource's office and in a prominent place on Enersource's website.
4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter.
5. To provide a copy of the Notice, application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
