- was non-discretionary in the IRM period, based on the following factors. THESL's criteria for
- making this determination is whether each project is required for one or more of the following
- 15 reasons:
- 16 (1) Statute, code, provincial policy, or equivalent external requirement;
- 17 (2) Considerations of safety for the public and for workers operating in, on, or around
- 18 equipment;
- 19 (3) Existing or imminent reliability degradations;
- 20 (4) Existing or imminent capacity shortages:
- 21 (5) A material increase in cost (beyond the time value of money), if the project is
- 22 necessary but undertaken at a later time.

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- On page 17, the Board stated under Board Findings: The Board accepts THESL's criteria for
- 25 determining if a project is non-discretionary.
