I object to any increase in residential electricity distribution rates. I object to this proposal even though it will be a fixed rather than variable rate.

The OEB notice of Nov. 17 states that it will: "...increase the amount it charges by approximately \$1.57 each month for the typical residential customer..." and "...will continue to be charged on how much electricity a customer uses."

My total monthly bills are about 50% for "electricity" and 50% for taxes, delivery, etc.!  
Therefore, as a pensioner on a fixed income I object to any increase in any form except for purely "electricity".
