Re: EB-2015-0216: November 19 2015 Decision and Order re: Upper Canada Transmission, Inc. Application for Approval of Schedule and Costs related to the Development of the East-West Tie Transmission Line (the "Decision") – Reporting Dates

On November 19, 2015, the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") issued its decision on schedule and costs related to the development of the East-West Tie transmission line for Upper Canada Transmission, Inc. ("UCT" or "NextBridge"). In the Decision, the Board ordered that:

"UCT is required to continue to report to the OEB quarterly on the matters as set out in the OEB's decision of January 22, 2015, commencing on January 15, 2016."

In the September 26, 2013 EB-2011-0140 decision on reporting, the Board ordered that:

"UCT is required to report to the Board on the 15th business day of each month, beginning on October 21, 2013, on the matters set out in Schedule 3 to UCT's licence."

UCT has been filing reports since then on the 15<sup>th</sup> <u>business</u> day of the appropriate month. The preference for the 15<sup>th</sup> business day, rather than the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month, was explained in UCT's August 28 2013 EB-2011-0140 compliance filing (page 5).

"...The 15th business day of October is Monday, October 21st. If NextBridge files its first monthly report on Monday, October 21st, the timing of the filing will ensure that the report reflects the financial status of the EWT Project development work through the end of September. This would allow for inclusion of a more meaningful financial update in the first monthly report...." UCT is prepared to comply with the November 19, 2015 Board Order and file on January 15, 2016 if that is the Board's preference. If it is a typographical error, and the intended date continues to be the 15<sup>th</sup> <u>business</u> day to ensure more meaningful financial updates, UCT respectfully requests the Board vary its decision to reflect the intended dates.
