Re: Application for Transmission Licence Amendment (ET-2010-0351)

Dear Ms. Walli,

I am writing in response to the Board's email of December 1, 2015, wherein the Board invited Entegrus Transmission Inc. ("ETI") to file an application with respect to ETI's Electricity Transmitter Licence in advance of its expiration on May 23, 2016.

Pursuant to the Board's Decision and Order dated November 2, 2011 in proceeding EB-2011-0260, ETI requests an amendment to its transmission licence. ETI hereby applies under Section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the "Act") to amend the effective date of its transmitter licence to the earlier of:

- The date upon which ETI is designated as a developer of transmission assets in Ontario pursuant to a Board designation process; or,
- The date upon which ETI applies to amend Schedule 1 of its licence to specify the facilities to be owned and/or operated by ETI.

Although ETI does not currently own or operate any electricity transmission assets in Ontario and is not a "transmitter" within the meaning of the Act, since 2011 ETI has conducted various business activities in continued anticipation of becoming a transmitter and conducting future transmission operations. These activities have included:

- The assembly of a "utility corridor" of land, extending approximately from Tilbury, Ontario to St. Thomas, Ontario;
- The provision of land rights to South Kent Wind ("SKW") LP in Chatham-Kent, Ontario (on which SKW's active transmission facilities are physically located); and,
- Ongoing discussions and negotiations regarding the provision of transmission facilities and services to various renewable generators.

ETI consents to the disposition of this application without the requirement for a hearing, as contemplated in Section 21(4)(b) of the Act. ETI submits that no other party will be adversely affected in a material way by the proposed amendment to its licence.
