In response to the Board's notice of application and hearing dated February 5, 2016, the Western Ontario Wardens' Caucus (WOWC) is applying for intervenor status in OEB-2016-0004. I am unable to forward paper copies of this request at this time, so I'm asking your indulgence in accepting this unaccompanied email.

The WOWC is an incorporated non-profit organization comprised of the elected Wardens of the Councils of the Counties of south-western Ontario. There are 15 Counties in the WOWC, stretching from Essex in the west to Simcoe in the east, with a combined population 3 million. Many residents in south-western Ontario live in rural settings, unserved by natural gas facilities.

The WOWC intends to participate in the proceedings by reviewing and commenting on the application and any documents filed pertaining to the application.

The WOWC has an interest in the expansion of natural gas services into unserved communities, an interest in fair costing and cost allocation of natural gas expansions, and the potential impact on existing properties currently serviced by natural gas.

The WOWC does not intend to seek an award of costs.
