Re: Application for Electricity Generation Licence

Please find enclosed an application for an Electricity Generation Licence for the PSS Generating Station Limited Partnership (the "Partnership") as required under sections 57(c), 57(f), and 60 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998.

The Partnership was formed between Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG"), PSS Generating Station Inc. and Coral Rapids Power Corporation ("CRP") – a corporation that is wholly owned by the Taykwa Tagamou Nation – to undertake the development, construction, ownership and operation of Peter Sutherland Senior Generating Station. Subject to the limited partnership agreement for the Partnership, the general partners of the Partnership are OPG and PSS Generating Station Inc. and the limited partner is CRP. The Partnership is seeking a licence to generate and sell electricity and ancillary services as the owner and operator of the 2-unit, 28-MW Peter Sutherland Senior Generating Station.

The Partnership asks that the OEB disposes of this proceeding without a hearing, in accordance with section 21(4) (b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*. The Partnership submits that this Electricity Generation Licence will not materially impact any other party.
