Application for leave to construct natural gas pipelines in the City of Windsor

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 March 8, 2016

Union Gas Limited (Union) applied on January 7, 2016 to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for approval to relocate two pipelines to accommodate the Windsor Detroit Bridge Authority's International Trade Crossing/Detroit River International Crossing project in the City of Windsor.

A Notice was issued on February 5, 2016 and was served and published as directed.

No requests for intervenor status were filed with the OEB.

I consider it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. If OEB staff require information and material from Union that is in addition to Union's evidence and that is relevant to the hearing, OEB staff shall request it by written interrogatories delivered to Union and filed with the OEB by **March 11, 2016**.
- 2. Union shall file with the OEB complete responses to the interrogatories by **March 24, 2016**.
- 3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, OEB staff may file any written submission with the OEB and deliver it to Union by **April 4, 2016**.
- 4. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, Union may file a written reply submission with the OEB by **April 11, 2016**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2015-0366 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal

at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.
