On March 11, 2016, Union Gas Limited (Union) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under s. 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for leave to construct a pipeline to replace two pipeline segments of Union's Sudbury System in the City of Greater Sudbury (2016 Sudbury Replacement Project).

The OEB has issued a Notice of Hearing for Union's application. The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. - a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
- b. the clerk of the City of Greater Sudbury
- c. all Aboriginal communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
- d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
- e. all affected utilities and railway companies
- f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union's office and in a prominent place on Union's website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
- 5. To provide a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
