Re: EB-2016-0028 - Enbridge Gas Distribution - Proposed Tariff for Parkway to Albion King's North (Rate 332) Transportation Service

I am a consultant to the Consumers Council of Canada ("Council"). I have been instructed by my client to intervene in the proceeding to consider the Application to the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") for approval of its proposed tariff for Parkway to Albion King's North (Rate 332) transportation service. The Council is a public-interest entity which represents the interests of residential consumers in Ontario. The Board's order in this proceeding may ultimately impact the rates that residential consumers pay for the delivery of natural gas.

On August 18, 2015, the Council filed with the Board, pursuant to Rule 22.03 of the Ontario Energy Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, a document describing the Council, its mandate and objectives, membership, the constituency represented, and the types of activities the Council carries out. In addition, we provided a list of the individuals authorized to represent the Council in Board proceedings.

The nature and scope of the Council's intended participation in the proceeding will be the following:

- 1. To review the evidence and assess whether the proposed tariff will have an impact on the rates paid by EGD's distribution rate customers. If there are implications for EGD's residential distribution customers we will assess the reasonableness of EGD's proposals;
- 2. If there are potential impacts on EGD's residential customers we may participate in the various aspects of the proceeding which may include an interrogatory process, a technical conference, a settlement conference and a hearing. Our level of participation will depend our initial review of the evidence.

The Council intends to ask for an order of costs in this proceeding. The Council has participated in many Enbridge proceedings over a long period of time. In all of those proceedings the Council has been recognized as being eligible for an award of costs. In the absence of an award of costs the Council would be unable to participate in this proceeding.
