Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.

**Application for approval of the tariff for transportation
service on the Albion Pipeline**

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

April 18, 2016

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (Enbridge) filed an application on March 10, 2016 with the Ontario Energy Board (the OEB) pursuant to section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, and sections 2.1.1 and 2.3.3 of the OEB's *Storage and Transportation Access Rule* (STAR) for an order approving Enbridge's terms of service, allocation methodology and rate schedule for gas transportation service under Rate 332 (collectively, the Tariff).

Enbridge will provide Parkway to Albion King's North Transportation Service on its Albion Pipeline (also known as Segment A of the GTA project) under Rate 332.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on March 31, 2016. The last date for intervention was April 14, 2016. The following parties applied for intervenor status.

- Association of Power Producers of Ontario (APPrO)
- Building Owners and Managers Association Toronto (BOMA)
- Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters (CME)
- Consumers Council of Canada (CCC)
- TransCanada Pipelines Ltd. (TransCanada)
- Union Gas Limited (Union)

APPrO, BOMA, CME, and CCC also applied for cost eligibility.

No objections were received regarding the requests for intervenor status or cost eligibility.

Intervenor status is granted to all parties that requested it. A list of intervenors in this proceeding is attached as Schedule A to this procedural order.

APPrO, BOMA, CME and CCC are each eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. Cost eligible intervenors should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party, unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed. The OEB also expects that intervenors will combine their interventions with those of similarly interested parties, will co-operate with all other parties to the extent possible and will be mindful to avoid duplication.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. OEB staff and intervenors who want information and material from Enbridge that is in addition to Enbridge's evidence, and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to Enbridge and all intervenors by **Wednesday, May 4, 2016**.
2. Enbridge shall file with the OEB complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors and OEB staff by **Wednesday, May 18, 2016**.
3. Unless otherwise ordered by the OEB, OEB staff and intervenors who wish to file written submissions shall file those submissions with the OEB, and deliver the submissions to Enbridge and all intervenors, by **Friday, June 3, 2016**.
4. If Enbridge wishes to reply to the submissions of other parties, the response shall be filed with the OEB, and delivered to all intervenors, by **Friday, June 17, 2016**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, **EB-2016-0028** and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed.

Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below.
