If Imperial Oil, a partnership of Imperial Oil Limited & McColl-Frontenac Petroleum Inc. wishes to continue to participate in the Ontario Electricity market, you are invited to file an application to renew Imperial Oil, a partnership of Imperial Oil Limited & McColl-Frontenac Petroleum Inc.'s Electricity Wholesaler Licence. As you are aware, Imperial Oil, a partnership of Imperial Oil Limited & McColl-Frontenac Petroleum Inc. is not permitted to carry out activities described in section 57 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (the "Act") without a licence.

The standard time required to issue a licence is 90 days from receipt of a complete application. To assist the Board to renew Imperial Oil, a partnership of Imperial Oil Limited & McColl-Frontenac Petroleum Inc.'s licence in a timely manner prior to the expiry date, you are required to submit your application to the Board within 30 days of this e-mail. On receipt of the application, the Board will proceed to review the application for renewal in accordance with Part V of the Act. If we do not receive the application by the required date, the Board will be prepared to remove the name from the licensee records once the current licence is expired.
