**Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.**

**Application for approval of the tariff for transportation  
service on the Albion Pipeline**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2**

**June 2, 2016**

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (Enbridge) filed an application on March 10, 2016 with the Ontario Energy Board (the OEB) pursuant to section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, and sections 2.1.1 and 2.3.3 of the OEB's *Storage and Transportation Access Rule* (STAR) for an order approving Enbridge's terms of service, allocation methodology and rate schedule for gas transportation service under Rate 332 (collectively, the Tariff).

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on April 18, 2016. In Procedural Order No. 1, the OEB granted intervenor status to a number of parties. The OEB also scheduled dates for filing interrogatories, responding to interrogatories, and filing submissions.

On June 2, 2016, Enbridge filed a letter noting that there is a minor error in the calculation of the Daily Contract Demand Charge. Enbridge stated that it intends to file an update to the evidence and its response to OEB staff interrogatory #1 later in the day on June 2, 2016.

The OEB originally established June 3, 2016 as the deadline for OEB staff and intervenors to file submissions. The Building Owners and Managers Association Toronto (BOMA) filed its submission on June 1, 2016. As Enbridge intends to file updated evidence one day prior to the deadline for filing submissions, the OEB finds that it is necessary to extend the deadline for submission filing. In addition, the OEB will grant BOMA the opportunity to file a supplementary submission if it wishes.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

### THE OEB ORDERS THAT:

1. OEB staff and intervenors who wish to file written submissions shall file those submissions with the OEB, and deliver the submissions to Enbridge and all intervenors, by **Wednesday, June 8, 2016**.
2. If Enbridge wishes to reply to the submissions of other parties, the response shall be filed with the OEB, and delivered to all intervenors, by **Wednesday, June 22, 2016**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, **EB-2016-0028** and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below.
