IN THE MATTER OF The Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B, and in particular, s.90 thereof;

AND IN THE MATTER OF Union Gas Limited, pursuant to Section 90(1) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, requests approval from the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") for leave to construct a natural gas pipeline and ancillary facilities in the City of Greater Sudbury;

AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE

 - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
 - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

- 3. On April 5, 2016, I did cause to make a copy of both the English and French Notice versions, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union's office and in a prominent place on Union's website.





THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Union. During the hearing, we will question Union on the case. We will also hear questions and arguments from individuals, municipalities and others whose interests would be affected. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to approve the application.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- · You can review the application filed by Union on the OEB's website now.
- · You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by April 18, 2016 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.
