Application for leave to transfer electricity generation licence EG-2003-0198 from H.J. Heinz Company of Canada Ltd. to Highbury Canco Corporation.

ORDER

On April 7, 2016, Highbury Canco Corporation (HCC) applied for leave of the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 18(2) *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to transfer an electricity generation licence EG-2003-0198 from H.J. Heinz Company of Canada Ltd. (Heinz) to HCC.

Electricity generation licence EG-2003-0198 was issued to H.J. Heinz Company of Canada Ltd. to own and operate a 7.4 MW natural gas-fired cogeneration power plant located in Learnington, Ontario. In 2014, Heinz ceased its food processing operations and all assets, including the generation facility, were acquired by HCC. As the applicant is now the owner and operator of the generation facility, they have requested to have the licence EG-2003-0198 transferred to Highbury Canco Corporation.

I have considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

I find that the application should be granted. The evidence in the application indicates that the applicant has a qualified management team and technical staff to operate the generation facility going forward.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application to transfer electricity generation licence EG-2003-0198 to Highbury Canco Corporation is granted.
