Re: 2014 DSM Clearance of Variance Accounts – EB-2015-0267
Enbridge Gas Distribution Comments on Intervenor Cost Claim Submission

In regards to the Ontario Energy Board's (the "Board") Notice of Hearing for Cost Awards for the 2014 Demand Side Management Clearance of Variance Accounts, EB-2015-0267, dated May 26, 2016, Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (the "Company") has reviewed the cost claims received from Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA), Industrial Gas User's Association (IGUA), and Ontario Sustainable Energy Association (OSEA).

Although the Company has no overall objection to the Intervenor Cost Claims we have noted the following items in our review:

- OSEA's claim has an error in the calculation of the 13% HST on the disbursement for Scanning/Photocopy; the HST should be adjusted from \$8 to \$1.98;
- BOMA's claim included a receipt for a courier disbursement which shows the base price of \$10.89 and the total billing amount of \$11.99. The receipt does not show an additional \$1.56 for HST; and
- the Company recognizes that the hours put forward for this matter varies greatly; with IGUA's hours being approximately 60% higher than the others combined.

The Company awaits the recommendations and or cost awards of the Board with respect to these cost claims.

Enbridge reserves the right to make submissions regarding any outstanding intervenor cost submissions which are subsequently received.
