Hydro One Inc.

Application for approval to purchase Great Lakes Power Transmission Inc.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 3 June 30, 2016

Hydro One Inc. (Hydro One) filed a complete application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 18, 2016 under section 86(2)(b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval to purchase the voting shares of Great Lakes Power Transmission Inc.

On May 18, 2016 the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 in which it approved intervenors and made provision for submissions and reply submissions on Hydro One's confidentiality requests, interrogatories and interrogatory responses.

In accordance with Procedural Order No. 1, OEB staff filed a submission on the confidentiality requests which was responded to by Hydro One. As well, OEB staff and intervenors have filed interrogatories and Hydro One filed its interrogatory responses on June 20, 2016.

On June 10, 2016, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 2 which made provision for tentative dates for a technical conference and/or oral hearing, if required. The OEB has reviewed interrogatory responses and has determined that further discovery is not required.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Hydro One shall file its Argument-in-chief with the OEB and serve it on all parties by **July 8, 2016.**
- OEB staff and intervenors shall make oral submissions to the OEB on July 14, 2016, from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the OEB's offices at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto.
- 3. Hydro One shall make its oral reply submissions to the OEB on **July 15, 2016**, beginning at 12:30 p.m. in the OEB's offices at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2016-0050, be made in searchable/ unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at

http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
