Comments

I am against an increase in fees on principle that the OPG seems mismanaged not only internally but externally.

OPG 50 highest earners enjoyed salary increases averaging 11 per cent in 2011. When 680 unionized staff earned more than their non-unionized bosses in 2012, OPG raised the salaries of 220 supervisors so they were at least 3 per cent higher than those of their unionized subordinates.

More than 60 per cent of OPG's 11,100 employees earned more than \$100,000 in 2012 and 448 made more than \$200,000.
