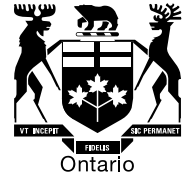

**Re: Dawn Parkway 2016 System Expansion Project  
Board File No. EB-2014-0261**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) is in receipt of your letter dated July 25, 2016 where Union Gas Limited (Union) informed the OEB of a change in temporary land use required to construct the 2016 Dawn Parkway System Expansion Project. Union requires additional temporary land use, adjacent to Courtcliffe Park, to accommodate construction of the pipeline within the park.

As the Manager, Application Policy and Climate Change, I have been delegated the authority of the OEB under Section 6 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 to determine whether Union's proposals will result in material changes to the leave to construct granted by the OEB in the EB-2014-0261 proceeding. I have been further granted the authority to approve any changes that I have concluded are not material.

For the requested change, you indicated that there are no proposed changes to the construction of the facilities or the restoration practices and no new environmental mitigation measures required. In addition, all of the necessary temporary land rights were acquired and no issues have been raised by the directly affected landowners.

Related to the change, there is an estimated \$250,000 cost increase. Union noted that the level of the contingency identified in Union's pre-file evidence exceeds these additional costs.

Based on my review of the information provided, I find that the described changes do not materially impact the leave granted by the OEB to construct the pipeline. I hereby approve the proposed change.
