Re: EB-2016-0152 - OPG 2017-2021 - SEC's Request For Access To Redacted Transcripts

Further to our letter of August 26, 2016 regarding the correspondence of School Energy Coalition ("SEC") dated August 24, 2016 concerning certain redacted transcripts relating to OPG's previous payment amounts proceeding (EB-2013-0321), this letter is to advise that OPG has reviewed the particular transcripts referenced by SEC. As a result of its assessment, OPG is of a view that:

- EB-2013-0321 transcript volumes 17 and 18 can be fully disclosed on the public record; and
- EB-2013-0321 technical conference transcript dated July 9, 2014 can be disclosed on the public record except for the following redactions on:
 - 1. Page 73, line 1;
 - 2. Page 133, lines 23-24;
 - 3. Page 134, lines 1-7, the second redaction on line 14, and line 15; and
 - 4. Page 165, lines 4-14.

Items 1-3 relate to commentary made on the performance of a specific contractor in the Darlington Refurbishment Program, or is otherwise information that would identify such contractor. The public disclosure of such information could potentially prejudice the competitive position of the relevant contractor, and could also give rise to adverse impacts on OPG's existing contractual relationship with the contractor. Furthermore, in EB-2013-0321, the OEB specifically considered the underlying reports that are the subject of the discussions in this transcript, and agreed that the disclosure of this type of information could lead to reputational harm to the contractor. The OEB ordered in EB-2013-0321 that this type of information be treated as confidential (Hearing Transcript, Vol. 12).

Item 4 relates to information which the SNC/Aecon JV has requested to be protected as confidential information in its submissions of August 24, 2016. Consistent with OPG's confidentiality request of May 27, 2016, OPG requests that such information be treated as confidential so as to not prejudice the position of the SNC/Aecon JV before the OEB.
