Horizon Utilities Corporation has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to decrease the amount it charges by approximately \$0.17 each month for the typical residential customer beginning on January 1, 2017. Other customers, including businesses, may be affected as well.

The requested rate decrease is based on a framework approved by the Ontario Energy Board for the period 2015 to 2019 and is tied to costs for 2017 which includes measures to promote efficiency.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider Horizon Utilities' request. We will determine whether Horizon Utilities has used the applicable models and formulas as required by the OEB. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide on the appropriate rate changes.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by [insert actual date 10 calendar days from the date the notice is posted on the applicant's website] or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
