RE: License Amendment Request - Inspection LAS Electricity Retail License ER-2014-0280

Local Authority Services (LAS) is requesting an amendment to our existing electricity retail license ER-2014-0280 to include low volume consumers. The form of our request is contained in this letter and follows the information requested on the OEB website under "License Amendments". Sections of the application form are used where the information requested as part of the amendment requires updating.

<u>Amendment</u> – LAS is currently licensed as an electricity retailer for Large Volume Consumers under License ER-2014-0280 which is LAS's DCB (Distributor Consolidated Billing) License. LAS is requesting an expansion of the current license to include both Large and Low Volume Consumers.

<u>Amendment Reasons</u> - The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) recently completed an Inspection of Local Authority Services (LAS) electricity retail license ER-2014-0280 – License Name "Local Authority Services". The Inspection was completed by Ms. Birgit Armstrong – Advisor, Investigations for the OEB. The investigation determined that LAS was not authorized to retail to low volume consumers and that LAS should submit a request to amend our current license to include low volume consumers. Please see attached letter to Ms. Armstrong in response to her request for Inspection and Ms. Armstrong's determination of the Inspection.

LAS' request to amend the current license is to ensure LAS' licenses support our business activities and to ensure compliance with market requirements.

No Hearing – LAS requests the Board dispose of the proceeding for the request for license amendment without a hearing as provided for in section 21(4) (b) of the Ontario Board Act, 1998. In support of this request LAS submits:

- LAS is incorporated as a not-for-profit organization under the laws of Canada and is part of the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) family of companies.
- LAS' mandate is to provide programs and services to Ontario municipalities to help realize lower costs or higher revenues through co-operative procurement efforts and innovative programs and services.
- Municipalities as a group are generally quite aware of the nature of the market and how the services provided by LAS are delivered to aid the supply of electricity and the price protection we provide. Our marketing support material aligns with keeping municipal customers correctly informed and educating them where required.
- Municipalities trust LAS because of our focus on municipalities and because we are part of the AMO family. However, municipalities can and do choose the appropriate electricity retailer for their needs.
- LAS' request for license amendment does not restrict marketing activities of other competitive retailers to provide offers to the low volume municipalities class,
- LAS's presence in the low volume customer class provides options and choice to these type of municipalities.

LAS consents to disposal of this proceeding without a hearing if so determined by the Board.

The following updates are provided to ensure the Board has complete and up to date information for LAS:

- Contact name Judy Dezell, Director AMO Enterprise Centre, Business Partnerships and LAS is the License Primary Contact and replaces Nancy Plumridge who is retiring at the end of September 2016. This information was previously submitted to the OEB and is included here for consistency,
- Application Primary Contact will also be Judy Dezell updated details are attached on the forms,
- Customer Complaint or Inquiries Primary Contact will also be Judy Dezell updated details are attached on the forms,
- Key Individuals Pat Vanini, was listed as the Managing Director in the current license. Pat's title has changed to LAS, President,
- Key Individuals Judy Dezell, Director AMO Enterprise Centre, Business Partnerships and LAS has been added as a key individual,
- Intended Services and Markets for consistency with the request to amend the current license the Intended Services include selling or offer to sell of electricity to both low volume consumers and large volume consumers,

LAS understands the requirements and our obligations for retailing to low volume consumers under the Energy Consumer Protection Act, 2010. We have been provided an exemption as a 'broader public-sector procurement agent" under section 27 of Ontario Regulation 389/10. LAS realizes this exemption focusses only on a portion of the activities of retailing to low volumes consumers. LAS expects to meet all other requirements that are not exempt.

Our intent will be to provide transparency in our offers and work with existing and potential customers so they can make informed decisions that best suit their needs.

I trust we have correctly presented LAS's request to amend our license scope and have provided the required supporting information.
