**Re: EB-2016-0152 – Ontario Power Generation (“OPG”) – Payment Amounts**

Further to your correspondence of November 9, 2016 regarding various questions posed by Environmental Defence for purposes of the technical conference and relating to the Darlington Refurbishment Program and Pickering Extended Operations, this letter is to advise you as to OPG's treatment of the questions posed.

OPG intends to proceed on the basis that for questions it intends to respond to, OPG will undertake to provide a response in writing and file such a response on November 21, 2016 along with other undertakings arising from the technical conference as set out in the Board's procedural order.

For those questions, which are relevant and directed to the IESO, OPG will provide those questions to the IESO for a written response to be filed by OPG on November 21, 2016.

There are, however, questions that OPG will or may object to and in this regard OPG will provide to Environmental Defence a reason for the objection at the technical conference at the outset of the examination of the applicable panel by Environmental Defence.


