Application for Electricity Retailer Licence Amendment

Order

Local Authority Services Limited filed an application on October 3, 2016 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to amend its electricity retailer licence ER-2014-0280. The amended licence would allow the applicant to retail electricity to consumers in Ontario.

Local Authority Services Limited has been licensed by the OEB as a "large-volume" electricity retailer since 2009. The applicant provides Electricity Procurement Programs to Ontario municipalities. As some municipalities served by LAS are small rural and northern municipalities with annual electricity consumption below 150,000 kWh¹, LAS's licence needs to be amended to ensure compliance with licensing requirements.

I have considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Local Authority Services Limited's electricity retailer licence ER-2014-0280 is amended. The amended licence is attached to this Order.
