Candu Energy's Submissions for Confidentiality related SG EPC Contract**

Further to your correspondence dated November 23, 2016, Candu Energy Inc., provides herein its supplementary submissions with regard to its request for confidentiality of certain portions of the SG EPC Contract.

Candu Energy Inc. is an affiliate of SNC-Lavalin Nuclear Inc. ("SNC") which is also identified as an intervenor in these proceedings in conjunction with its joint venture partner, Aecon Construction Group Inc. (the "SNC/Aecon JV").

In response to the Decision on Confidential Filings and Procedural Order No.3 dated November 1, 2016, the SNC/Aecon JV filed on November 11, 2016, supplementary submissions addressing certain questions made by the Board (the "SNC/Aecon Submission").

Given (i) the similarities in contractual provisions as between the SG EPC Contract and the SNC/Aecon contracts subject to these proceedings, (ii) the similarities with regard to the nature of the information for which confidential treatment is being sought by Candu and the SNC/Aecon JV, (iii) that the questions raised by the Board in its Decision are equally applicable to Candu in respect of its request for confidentiality as they are to the SNC/Aecon JV, and (iv) given Candu's affiliation with SNC, Candu hereby relies upon, adopts and submits the reasoning and arguments submitted by SNC in the SNC/Aecon Submission, in response to the Board's Decision and Procedural Order No.3. and in further support of Candu's claim for confidentiality.
