**Re: Henvey Inlet - Application for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities
(EB-2016-0310) – Amendment to Application and Pre-filed Evidence**

We are counsel to Henvey Inlet Wind GP Inc. and Henvey Inlet Wind LP (together, “Henvey”) in respect of the above-referenced proceeding. Although Henvey filed its application on October 14, 2016, the Board has not yet issued a Letter of Direction or the Notice of Application. Henvey is hereby amending one aspect of its application, described below, and asks that the Letter of Direction and Notice, when issued, reflect this amendment.

The application seeks leave to construct transmission facilities based on a particular transmission line route, but also seeks approval for two potential route variations that would deviate from the main route in certain places. The route variations were included because Henvey was concerned about its ability to secure the necessary land rights on two First Nations Reserves (Magnetawan and Shawanaga) within a reasonable period. Since filing the application, Henvey has made significant progress in its communications with these First Nations and is now confident that it will be able to secure the necessary land rights through these First Nations Reserves within a reasonable period. Consequently, Henvey is amending its application to remove the requests for approval of the potential route variations.


