The applicant also says that customers will not pay the costs of the sale or the premium paid by EPCOR Natural Gas.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The OEB will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Natural Resource Gas. We will question the company on the case. We will also hear arguments from individuals and from groups that represent the customers of Natural Resource Gas. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to approve the application.

- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by **March 13, 2017** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
