ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.55, as amended;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited for an Order approving a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct works to supply natural gas in the City of Cambridge.

APPLICATION

- 1. Union Gas Limited ("Union"), a regulated public utility, is a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, with its head office at the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, in the Province of Ontario.
- 2. On August 19, 2016, Union was directed by the Ontario Energy Board to file a report by December 31, 2016 confirming that Union has obtained Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity covering the geographic areas in which its facilities are located. If during its investigation facilities are found to be located in areas where it does not hold Certificate rights, Union is to advise the Board as to where the infrastructure is located and to provide a plan to rectify the situation.
- 3. The City of Cambridge was formed on January 1, 1973 with the amalgamation of the former City of Galt, the former Towns of Preston and Hespeler, and the former Hamlet / Village of Blair.
- 4. Union currently holds a 20-year Franchise Agreement with the City of Cambridge dated January 16, 2006 (EB-2005-0521). Union also has Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity F.B.C. 259 issued on March 17, 1959 for several communities including the former City of Galt, the former Town of Preston and the former Town of Hespeler. There is no evidence that a Certificate was issued for the former Hamlet / Village of Blair.
- 5. During its investigation of Certificates, Union determined that there are natural gas distribution facilities serving customers within the former Hamlet / Village of Blair.
- 6. Attached hereto and marked as Schedule "A" is a map showing the location of the City of Cambridge.

Union now applies to the Ontario Energy Board for an Order pursuant to Section 8 of the *Municipal Franchises Act* cancelling and superseding those parts of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity F.B.C. 259 related to the former City of Galt, the former Town of Preston and the former Town of Hespeler and replacing them with a single Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the City of Cambridge.
