## Re: Union Gas Limited ("Union") 2017 Panhandle Replacement (Jefferson) EB-2017-0118

This letter will update the Ontario Energy Board regarding the proposed route of the 2017 Panhandle Replacement (Jefferson), located in the City of Windsor.

Discussions with the Windsor International Airport ("Airport") regarding the route of the proposed pipeline have been ongoing since mid-2016. On February 23, 2017 the Airport provided Union with a letter on non-objection for the proposed route of the pipeline. With that letter from the Airport, Union filed the EB-2017-0118 application. Subsequent to Union filling its OEB application, Staff at the Airport met to review the initial proposal, and determined that there was the potential for future development at the corner of Rhodes Drive and Jefferson Blvd which would impact the location of the proposed pipeline. Airport Staff requested that Union review the western section of the proposed route to determine if the proposed line could be moved to the north to allow for the future development to occur.

Union and Airport staff met on March 22, 2017 and agreed to a new location for the proposed facilities.

Attached please find two maps showing the revised location of the proposed facilities and a letter for the Airport agreeing with the new location of the proposed pipeline.

## Re: Union Gas Limited ("Union") 2017 Panhandle Replacement Pipeline Project Windsor Airport Replacement

After reviewing your proposal to replace the NPS 16 pipeline to the east of Jefferson Blvd., YQG, has no objection to the location described by Drawing PL1036 Revision 1 - March 23, 2017 (attached), or to the construction methodology proposed by Union Gas; provided that the pipeline is buried to a minimum of 60" below grade, backfilled with sand layer and marked with safety tape inside of the trench.

YQG will await the final detailed engineering drawings for final review and approval. Once you have these  $\geq$  documents please forward them to my attention.

After YQG has reviewed these drawings and is able to determine the land required for construction of the proposed facilities, we will advise you of the next steps with respect to determining compensation and the relevant documents that are required.
