# Application for payment amounts for the period from January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2021

# PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 8 April 18, 2017

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 27, 2016 under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes in payment amounts for the output of its nuclear generating facilities and most of its hydroelectric generating facilities. The request seeks approval for nuclear payment amounts to be effective January 1, 2017 and for each following year through to December 31, 2021. The request seeks approval for hydroelectric payment amounts to be effective January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017 and approval of the hydroelectric payment amount setting formula for the period January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2021.

The filing dates for written submissions were set during the oral hearing on April 6, 2017, and are provided in this procedural order.

The OEB encourages all parties to prepare their submissions such that there is minimal or no need for redactions or confidential treatment of the submissions. This in turn will assist the OEB in issuing a decision that does not require confidential treatment.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

# THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- 1. OPG shall file its Argument in Chief with the OEB and deliver it to all other parties by **May 3, 2017**.
- 2. OEB staff shall file its submission with the OEB and deliver it to all other parties by **May 19, 2017**.
- 3. Parties shall file their submissions with the OEB and deliver them to all other parties by **May 29, 2017**.
- 4. OPG shall file its reply submission with the OEB and deliver it to all other parties by **June 19, 2017**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2016-0152**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>http://www.oeb.ca/industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
