Re: Union Gas Limited 2017 Panhandle Replacement Project (Jefferson) Board File Number EB-2017-0118

On March 2, 2017, Union Gas Limited (Union Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under s. 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for approval to construct 600 metres of 16 inch diameter pipeline in its Panhandle Pipeline System in the City of Windsor, County of Essex. Construction involves removing the existing 16 inch diameter pipeline and replacing it with a new 16 inch diameter pipeline to comply with current land use and population density design requirements (2017 Panhandle Replacement Project (Jefferson)).

The OEB has therefore issued a Notice of Hearing for Union Gas's application (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 2 and 3 below **prior to May 3**, **2017**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. You are directed:

- 1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Union Gas's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of both the English and French versions of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
 - all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above
 - b. the clerk of the City of Windsor, County of Essex
 - c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
 - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
 - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
 - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union Gas's office and in a prominent place on Union Gas' website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
- 5. To provide a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
