**NOTICE OF HEARING  
AND  
PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1**

**April 25, 2017**

On February 1, 2017, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), on its own motion under section 112.2 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (Act), issued a Notice of Intention (Notice of Intention) to make an Order under section 112.4 of the Act to revoke electricity unit sub-metering licence ES-2012-0461 issued to Ensqr Corporation (Ensqr).

Allegations of non-compliance are set out in the Notice of Intention.

By way of a letter dated February 14, 2017, Ensqr requested that the OEB hold a hearing in this matter.

**Parties to this Proceeding**

The parties to the proceeding are Ensqr and the members of OEB staff assigned to bring these matters forward (the Enforcement Team).

## Disclosure

Rule 16 of the OEB's *Rules of Practice and Procedure for Enforcement Proceedings* (the Enforcement Rules) set out provisions regarding the disclosure of documents in enforcement proceedings. The OEB will require the parties to make disclosure to one another in accordance with Rules 16.02 and 16.03 of the Enforcement Rules, in the manner set out below, to the extent that they have not already done so. As set out in Rule 16.05 of the Enforcement Rules, a document that is not disclosed as required under the Enforcement Rules shall not be introduced as evidence in this proceeding except with leave of the OEB.

The OEB will proceed by way of oral hearing.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

### THE OEB ORDERS THAT:

1. The OEB Enforcement Team shall file with the OEB a copy of every document it intends to produce or enter into evidence in this proceeding and serve a copy on Ensqr, on or before **May 25, 2017**.
2. The OEB Enforcement Team shall file with the OEB a list of the witnesses that the Enforcement Team intends to call in this proceeding, together with a witness statement or a summary of the anticipated oral evidence of each witness, and serve a copy on Ensqr on or before **May 25, 2017**.
3. Ensqr shall file with the OEB a copy of every document it intends to produce or enter into evidence in this proceeding and serve a copy on the OEB Enforcement Team's Counsel (Mr. Justin Safeyeni) on or before **June 8, 2017**. Mr. Safeyeni's contact information is set out below:

Ensqr shall file with the OEB a list of the witnesses that it intends to call in this proceeding, together with a witness statement or a summary of the anticipated oral evidence of each witness, and serve a copy on the OEB Enforcement Team Counsel (Mr. Justin Safeyeni) on or before **June 8, 2017**.
5. An oral hearing will take place in the OEB's North Hearing room beginning at **9:30 a.m. on July 13, 2017** at 2300 Yonge Street on the 25<sup>th</sup> Floor.

All filings to the OEB must quote file number EB-2016-0380 and be made electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/> in searchable/unrestricted PDF format. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
