En-Powered Inc.

Application Electricity Retailer Licence

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

May 11, 2017

En-Powered Inc. filed an application on March 13, 2017 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for a renewal of its electricity retailer licence. The granting of this licence would enable the applicant to continue retailing electricity in Ontario.

The OEB issued a Notice of Application and Written Hearing on March 31, 2017. In that Notice, the OEB set out dates for the filing of interrogatories, responses to the interrogatories and written submissions. Responses to interrogatories were due on May 10, 2017.

In a letter filed with the OEB dated May 11, 2017, En-Powered Inc. requested an extension to May 17, 2017 for filing responses to OEB staff's interrogatories stating that to complete certain responses to OEB staff interrogatories has taken longer than expected.

The OEB will grant the extension and finds it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. En-Powered Inc. shall file responses to interrogatories by **May 17, 2017**.
2. Written submissions must be filed with the OEB by **May 30, 2017**.
3. If En-Powered Inc. wishes to respond to the submissions, its written response must be filed with the OEB by **June 9, 2017**.

All filings to the OEB must quote file number EB-2017-0130, be made through the OEB's web portal at www.pes.oeb.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.oeb.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the BoardSec@oeb.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the Board's web portal an e-mail is not required.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
