In 2007, Hydro One and Newmarket-Tay jointly applied to the OEB to address Long Term Load Transfers ("LTLT"s) between Hydro One and Newmarket-Tay that resulted in the elimination of 48(of the 54 total) LTLT customers and associated facilities from Hydro One to Newmarket-Tay under OEB April4,2008 Decision and OrderEB-2007-0792. The anticipated load growth for expansion of Newmarket-Tay's distribution system to directly serve the remaining 6 LTLT customers did not materialize until after the 2015 LTLT elimination timeframe, making it more efficient to maintain these last 6 remaining LTLTs. A joint Service Area Application ("SAA") for elimination of these last 6 remaining LTLT customers involving Newmarket-Tay Power Distribution Ltd. was filed with the OEB on May 15, 2017.

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
