#### **Union Gas Limited**

Application for approval to construct a natural gas pipeline in the City of Windsor, County of Essex.

#### PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

June 2, 2017

On March 2, 2017, Union Gas Limited (Union Gas) applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) under s. 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for approval to construct 600 metres of 16 inch diameter pipeline in its Panhandle Pipeline System in the City of Windsor, County of Essex. Construction involves removing the existing 16 inch diameter pipeline and replacing it with a new 16 inch diameter pipeline to comply with current land use and population density design requirements.

A Notice of Hearing was issued on April 25, 2017 and was served and published as directed.

The OEB did not receive any requests for intervention.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

# THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- OEB staff shall request any information and material from Union Gas that is in addition to Union Gas' evidence and that is relevant to the hearing by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to Union Gas by June 9, 2017.
- 2. Union shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories by **June 16, 2017**.
- 3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, OEB staff shall file a written submission with the OEB and deliver it to Union Gas by **June 23, 2017**.

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4. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, Union Gas may file a written reply submission with the OEB by **June 30, 2017**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2017-0118 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <a href="https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/">https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</a>. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.
