Re: Henvey Inlet (EB-2016-0310) - Jeffrey Hull Cost Claim

We are counsel to Henvey Inlet Wind LP ("Henvey") in the above-referenced proceeding. This letter is filed in response to the cost claim and additional information filed by counsel on behalf of Jeffrey Hull on June 1, June 4 and June 6, 2017. While Henvey does not object to the claim, Henvey does have some concerns that it wishes to bring to the Board's attention, which the Board may wish to consider in reviewing and processing the claim, as follows:

- Although the June 1 claim was for 15 hours of time for a total of \$5,593.50 and the June 4 materials ask for costs based on 21 hours of time for a total of \$7,830.90, counsel offered no explanation for the increased amount of the claim.
- The dockets do not align with the cost classification in the June 4 materials. For example:
 - it appears that 3.7 hours were spent on preparing argument (April 25-27) rather than the 5.0 hours indicated;
 - the June 4 materials indicate 1.0 hours for Mr. Bisceglia but the dockets show 0.4 hours for him, of which 0.2 hours was docketed on October 20, 2016 despite that the Notice of Application was not served until January 12, 2017.
 - the June 4 materials indicate 5.0 hours for "Pre-hearing Conference" despite that the proceeding did not include a Pre-hearing Conference; and
 - the June 4 materials indicate 6.0 hours for "Interrogatories" despite that only one short interrogatory question was filed, on March 27, 2017.
- The dockets include a number of items that are outside the scope of the proceeding, namely the environmental matters referenced on May 3-5 and the emails and calls from May 8-13, which were subsequent to Henvey filing its reply submissions.
