AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Union Gas Limited for an Order granting leave to construct a natural gas pipeline and ancillary facilities in the City of Greater Sudbury.

AFFIDAVIT OF SERVICE

I, Mary Jane Patrick, of Municipality of Chatham-Kent, in the Province of Ontario,

MAKE OATH AND SAY:

That I am an employee in the Registered Office of Union Gas Limited and, as such, have knowledge of the matters herein deposed to.

1. On June 9, 2017, I did cause to have a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities conducted.
2. On June 12, 2017, I arranged for the service of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to the following by email/courier/registered mail:
 - a. all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above.

 - c. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
 - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
 - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
 - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

3. On June 9th, 2017, I did cause to make a copy of the English and French Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union's office and in a prominent place on Union's website.


Union Gas Limited has applied for approval to construct a natural gas pipeline in the City of Greater Sudbury.

Learn more. Have your say.

Union Gas Limited has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval to construct 20 kilometres of 12 inch diameter pipeline to replace two sections of the existing 10 inch diameter pipeline of its Sudbury Pipeline System in the City of Greater Sudbury.

The construction involves removing the existing 10 inch diameter pipeline and replacing it with a new 12 inch diameter pipeline at most locations between Coniston Primary Station and Frood Receiver Site and of laying a new 12 inch diameter pipeline along the existing 10 inch pipeline between Azilda Takeoff and Walden Town Border Station.

A map of the proposed pipeline project is provided below.



THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD IS HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Union Gas. During the hearing, we will question Union Gas on the case. We will also hear questions and arguments from individual consumers, municipalities and others whose interests would be affected. At the end of this hearing, the OEB will decide whether to approve the application.

As part of its review of this application, the OEB will assess Union Gas' compliance with the OEB's Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction and Operation of Hydrocarbon Pipelines and Facilities in Ontario.

The OEB will also assess whether the duty to consult with Indigenous communities potentially affected by the proposed pipeline has been discharged with respect to the application.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review the application filed by Union Gas on the OEB's website now.
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by **June 26, 2017** or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding.
- At the end of the process, you can review the OEB's decision and its reasons on our website.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. However, your personal telephone number, home address and email address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This hearing will be held under section 90(1) of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).

AVIS DE LA COMMISSION DE L'ÉNERGIE DE L'ONTARIO

Union Gas Limited a déposé une requête en vue d'obtenir l'approbation de construire un gazoduc dans la ville du Grand Sudbury.

Soyez mieux renseigné. Donnez votre opinion.

Union Gas Limited a déposé une requête auprès de la Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario afin de recevoir l'autorisation de construire un gazoduc de 20 kilomètres de long et de 12 pouces de diamètre afin de remplacer deux sections de 10 pouces de diamètre du système de gazoducs de la ville du Grand Sudbury.

Les travaux consistent à enlever le gazoduc existant de 10 pouces de diamètre et à le remplacer par une nouvelle canalisation de 12 pouces de diamètre dans la plupart des emplacements situés entre la station primaire Coniston jusqu'au point de réception Frood. Par la suite, un nouveau gazoduc de 12 pouces de diamètre sera installé à partir de celui existant situé entre la station de départ Azilda et la station se trouvant aux limites de la ville de Walden.

Un plan du projet de gazoduc proposé est fourni ci-dessous.

LA COMMISSION DE L'ÉNERGIE DE L'ONTARIO TIENDRA UNE AUDIENCE PUBLIQUE

La Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario (CEO) tiendra une audience publique durant laquelle elle examinera la requête d'Union Gas. Au cours de l'audience, la CEO interrogera Union Gas sur ce dossier. 1. Union Gas Limited (the “Applicant”) hereby applies to the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”), pursuant to Section 90(1) of the Ontario Energy Board Act (the “Act”), for leave to construct 20 kilometres of NPS 12 hydrocarbon (natural gas) pipeline (“Proposed Pipeline”), to replace two sections of the existing Sudbury lateral NPS 10 Line located in the City of Greater Sudbury.
2. Attached hereto as Schedule “A” is a map showing the general location of the proposed pipeline and the municipalities, highways, railways, and utility lines, under, over, upon or across which the Proposed Pipeline will pass.
3. The construction of the Proposed Pipeline will ensure the continued reliable, safe delivery of natural gas and meet the growing demands for natural gas in The City of Greater Sudbury.
4. The Applicant now therefore applies to the Board for an Order granting leave to construct the Proposed Pipeline as described above.


