EnWin Utilities Ltd.

Application for Recovery of Stranded Meter Costs Effective November 1, 2017

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 June 14, 2017

EnWin Utilities Ltd. (EnWin Utilities) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 14, 2017 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) and under the OEB's Filing Requirements for Electricity Distribution Rate Applications section 2.2.1.4, as well as section 3.7 and Appendix A-1 of the Board's Guideline for Smart Meter Funding and Cost Recovery, seeking approval for the recovery of stranded meter costs to be effective November 1, 2017.

The OEB issued a Notice of Hearing on May 8, 2017. No Intervenor requests were received.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- OEB staff shall request any information and material from EnWin Utilities that is in addition to EnWin Utilities' evidence and that is relevant to the hearing by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to EnWin Utilities by July 4, 2017.
- 2. EnWin Utilities shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories, by **July 25, 2017.**

- 3. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, any written submission by OEB staff shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to EnWin Utilities, by **August 24, 2017**.
- 4. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, EnWin Utilities may file a written reply submission with the OEB, by **September 7, 2017.**

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2017-0132 and be made electronically in searchable/unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at https://www.oeb.ca/industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
