



# Map #1 2576 Derry Road



# Map #2 2580 Derry Road





# Burlington Hydro/ Milton Hydro - LTLT Elimination Sample Customer Letter

## Notice of Changes to Your Electricity Distributor

Dear Valued Customer:

We are writing to advise that, in approximately eight weeks, you will be billed by a new electricity distributor. Your place of (home/business) is on the border of Milton and Burlington. You are currently a Burlington Hydro Inc. customer paying Burlington Hydro Inc.'s rates and are serviced and billed by Burlington Hydro Inc. However, your electricity is physically supplied by Milton Hydro Distribution Inc.

To simplify the process and comply with the Ontario Energy Board's ("OEB") Distribution System Code, to be followed by electricity distributors, we have requested approval from the OEB to transfer your account to Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. Upon approval, Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. will be responsible for servicing and billing, in addition to supplying your electricity.

We are making this change to serve you better. In addition to offering one-stop servicing of your electricity needs, it is more cost effective for you to have the same distributor deliver electricity to your (home/business) and provide you with customer service. Once this transfer is complete, Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. will be responsible for delivering your electricity, reading your meters, issuing your monthly bills, restoring power during outages and providing you with quality customer service.

As this transfer results in a higher electricity delivery charge, the increase will be offset by a credit applied by Milton Hydro Distribution Inc.on your bill, as long as you remain the account holder.
