The above property is seasonal in use. For the past 12 month period, delivery charges as per the attached summary amount to 54.72% of my bill. My electricity charge (both summer and winter) only amounts to 19.78% of my bill. And now I here from Hydro One that they are making application to the OEB to increase my delivery charges by \$11.75/mth over the next five years to \$141.00/yr. This would take delivery charges to 58.36% of my bill assuming hydro charges do not increase over the next five years. I do not support this application as I believe it is another attempt to increase consumer costs without any noticeable or declared attempts to reduce delivery costs.
