Please consider that there are already huge burdens on residents from massive hydro bills, and do not allow this rate increase. Our province already pays more for hydro than most, and for those of us in rural areas, it's huge. In the last year I have paid between 400 and 800 a month for hydro, and cannot afford an increase. Your examples do not reflect what my increases would be, as I am heating with electric and am in rural eastern Ontario. As a single mom of 3 kids, I can afford another penny in hydro, and cannot afford to upgrade to more efficient equipment since I am spending so much on hydro.

It's a terrible dilemma, as I can't afford the hydro, and need newer, more efficient equipment, but can't afford the upgrade without hydro relief. Also, I am paying a huge amount every month in delivery charges already, enough is enough
