I am opposed to this rate increase. In view of the fact that the Government of Ontario has acknowledged that hydro rates are out of control and have implemented measures to roll those rates back, it would be inappropriate, in my opinion, for the OEB to grant additional increases during the period for which this application covers.

Continual rate increases continue to cause additional strains on limited resources of all Hydro One customers and, while I respect that repairs and maintenance play a major part in keeping the power on, I believe that there are an ample number of places where Hydro One could find the funds to perform these tasks.
