Dear Board Members at the OEB,

I am writing to you regarding Hydro One's recent application to raise electricity prices. This \$141 per year rate increase is unfair and unaffordable. It must be stopped.

- 1. Please legislate the same "Meter Charge" be shown on Hydro Bills that the gas companies put on their bills. At the moment, it's part of the Delivery Charge, making it hard to calculate the kWhr delivery rate charged by Hydro One or any by butility.
- 2. Ontarians knew all along that Premier Wynne would raise rates after the next election. But we had no idea that she'd allow it to happen before the next election!
- 3. Please require OPG to stop refurbishing Pickering & Darlington when they reach their Bad After dates.
