I wish like to raise a strong opposition to the increase in delivery rates applied for by Hydro One Networks. With the information given, my rough calculations are that this increase is in the order of 20% PER YEAR (!) for the next 5 years, meaning that Hydro One will be charging twice as much for deliver 5 years from now. It would be completely unreasonable to imagine any scenario of improvement of service or quality for their customers that would result from this. The OMB and Hydro One both have a responsibility to keep these costs under control; allow such an increase would be an blatant disregard for the position of responsibility they have been given, and an irresponsible effect on the rate of inflation, and subsequently the economy of this province.
