I wish to lodge an objection to this proposal.

Hydro costs currently form a major part of household income, in some cases particularly in rural areas such as ours, the monthly hydro cost can equal or exceed an average mortgage payment.

This is particularly onerous on either end of the 'lifetime' scale - ie starting out or retirement, where financing is still an issue.

The current Ontario government clearly recognizes this financial burden in as much as they have recently instigated relief initiatives which are now apparently being 'clawed back' from the consumer by the service supplier - i am pretty sure that this would not have been the intent when these credits were put in place.
