This request to the Energy Board in the wake of a provincial Liberal Government 'sell off' of 49% interest in Hydro One last year, just shows me where we are headed going forward, with the highest power rates in North America just getting worse, if one can imagine. If you do not rein in power costs in the Province of Ontario, existing businesses and future business investment & development in our province are DOOMED if we continue on this path.....there is a lot at risk here and this has to be recognized NOW, to avoid the fallout that is sure to come.
