I believe hydro delivery charges should NOT be applied on a percentage of amount of hydro used, but rather a set cost per address. My neighbour uses gas for heat and I use all electric heat, and my delivery averages \$118 per month where his is less than \$60 per month. The same amount of electricity goes to our neighbourhood. The charge should not be for delivery at different rates. As someone on radio once said, "I would like to see the two delivery trucks, since mine is much higher than my neighbour's."
