I strongly disagree with this application's success. While it is presented as a general monthly increase, over the 5 yr period it will equal 11.75 per month or just shy of 144.00 per year. It is stated in the letter received that this is one of 5 lines that show on our bill.

If each line item under separate requests receives the same rate increase over the 5 yr period, then we are talking in excess of 700.00 per year. I realize there are increases under the current economic system, and that those other potential rate increases are not under review at this time. However, as a customer on pension, my pension will not increase that much over a year and will severely affect my standard of living.

Unless and until Hydro One Inc which is supposed to be a public service, stops selling shares to private corporations and reduces its profits to zero, then there is absolutely no justification for any rate increases whatsoever.
